



## Adopt a Tree

TEA helps to care for the Esplanade's roughly 2,000 trees, a wide array of species that include extraordinary specimens of weeping willow. When you adopt a tree, you support our pruning and maintenance initiative, which keeps the park's trees healthy and strong. Under the program, we profile a Tree of the Month on the TEA website and review some of the finer points of the Esplanade's tree collection. As a tree sponsor, you can request a certificate, photograph, and map showing the location of your tree. You can adopt in someone else's name, too, making this a unique gift that celebrates a friend, commemorates a momentous occasion, or honors the memory of a loved one.

### Levels of Adoption:

#### \$1,000—Adopt a Tree

Choose a tree along the Esplanade or one from our Tree of the Month collection.

#### \$2,500—Adopt a Willow

Willow trees date to the creation of the Esplanade and follow the original planting design created by Charles Eliot and Arthur Shurcliff.
